CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That **JAMES S. AND VERLE E. WALTERS**
629 S. E. 96th Street, Portland, and
of 12815 S.E. Powell Blvd., Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Kellogg Creek
a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of
irrigation
under Permit No. 15837 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from June 24, 1944

; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.165 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within A. P. Smith D.L.C.
No. 63, Section 5, Township 2 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

1.2 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within A. P. Smith D.L.C. No. 63
0.4 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within A. P. Smith D.L.C. No. 63
1.8 acre in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within A. P. Smith D.L.C. No. 63
9.8 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within A. P. Smith D.L.C. No. 63
Section 5

Township 2 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by
appropriator as follows:

The following described property in County of Clackamas and state of Oregon:
Part of A. P. Smith D.L.C. No. 63, T. 2 S. R. 2 E. of the W.M., more particularly
described as commencing on the South side of Morningside, 1318.17 feet north and
544 feet west of the intersection of the North line of the W. T. Matlock Claim
with the section lines between sections 4 and 5, T. 2 S. R. 2 E. of the W.M.,
thence North 86° 30' west along the south side of Morningside, 1053 feet to the
east line of a tract conveyed to Phode A. Gilbert by deed recorded in book 52,
page 6, deed records; thence south 20' east along the east line of said Gilbert
tract, 1428.5 feet to the North line of the McCoron tract, thence south 80° east
782.1 feet to the southwest corner of tract sold by R. W. Gilbert, to Hans Olsen
thence North 15° 8' east along west line of Olsen tract 782.7 feet to north line
of right of way of Oregon and California Railroad; thence easterly along said
right of way 100 feet to a point 20 feet South of the southwest corner of tract
sold by R. W. Gilbert to Thomas Francis; thence North along the west line of said
Francis tract 780 feet to the place of beginning except Railroad right of way.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
