CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** HOLLIS R. MARPLE

of Route 1, Box 321, Beaver Creek, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, tributary of Clear Creek, a tributary of Clackamas River, for the purpose of domestic use for one family, including irrigation of  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre domestic lawn & garden, stock & poultry, under Permit No. 15844 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 29, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2 gallons per minute,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 3, Township 4 South, Range 3 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 3  
Township 4 South, Range 3 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:  
The Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 3, T. 4 S., R. 3 E., of W.M., and also the following tract, to-wit:  
Commencing at the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of Section 34, T. 3 S. R. 3 E., of W.M., thence west 50 rods; thence north 68 rods; thence east 50 rods; thence south along the quarter section line 68 rods to the point of beginning, subject to the rights of the public in and to that portion in road.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
