CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That W. R. AND LUCILE S. WILMOT

of Route 1, Box 700, Lake Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Three Sisters Spring, tributary of Spring Brook, a tributary of Oswego Lake, for the purpose of domestic use for one family, including irrigation of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre lawn under Permit No. 16007 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 3, 1944;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 5
Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Description of property on which Three Sisters Spring located: Beginning at a point in the division line between the north and south half of the Waters-Carman Donation Land Claim, at a point north 5 minutes east 3.56 chains and north 89 degrees and 40 minutes, west 8.32 chains from the quarter corner on the south boundary line of Section 5, Township 2 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian; thence north 89 degrees, 40 minutes west 12.26 chains, tracing the division line between the north and south half of the said Carman Donation Land Claim; thence north 8.22 chains to the center of the road; thence south 67 degrees and 10 minutes east 4.56 chains along the said road; thence north 20 degrees and 50 minutes east 4.41 chains; thence north 10.80 chains parallel to the east boundary line of Charles Brown's Donation Land Claim, which is numbered 64; thence south 89 degrees and 40 minutes east 6.58 chains, and parallel with the half section line between the southwest quarter and the northwest quarter of said Section 5, and passing north of the Three Sisters Springs; thence south 5 minutes west 11.82 chains, and parallel to the half section line between the southwest quarter and the southeast quarter of said Section 5; thence south 19 degrees west 5 chains to the center of the road; thence south 71.10 minutes east 1.75 chains along said road; thence south 5 minutes west 3.70 chains and parallel to the half section line between the southeast quarter and the southwest quarter of said Section 5, to the place of beginning; and containing 17.17 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
