CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That VINEYARD IRRIGATION ASSOCIATION
CHARLES RULLMAN, JR., PRESIDENT

of 2615 S.E. Vineyard Way, Milwaukie, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 16404 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 9, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.021 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within S. H. Walker D.L.C. No. 52, Section 13, Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.8 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within the S. H. Walker D.L.C. No. 52
- 0.2 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within the S. H. Walker D.L.C. No. 52
- 0.5 acre in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within the S. H. Walker D.L.C. No. 52
- 0.2 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within the S. H. Walker D.L.C. No. 52

Section 13
Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

A part of the S. H. Walker D.L.C. No. 52 in Township 2 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian. Beginning at an iron pipe on the southwesterly line side of River Road, which iron pipe is South 66° 52' West 863.8 feet distant from a point which is 751.10 feet South and 201.30 feet East of the quarter section corner between Sections 12 and 13, Township 2 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian, running thence North 51° 59' West 364.70 feet along the southwesterly side of said River Road to an iron pipe, thence South 66° 35' West 857.05 feet to an iron pipe, thence South 23° 25' East 59.09 feet to an iron pipe, thence South 52° 41' East 76.35 feet to an iron pipe, thence on a curve with a radius of 43.77 feet on a 60° 27' curve to the left 46.18 feet to an iron pipe, thence N. 66° 52' East 704.25 feet to an iron pipe, thence North 62° 24' East 154.55 feet to an iron pipe on the Southwesterly side of River Road, thence South 51° 59' East 34.25 feet to an iron pipe, thence South 62° 51' West 170.9 feet to an iron pipe, thence South 66° 52' West 655.60 feet to an iron pipe, thence on a curve to the left having a radius of 10 feet through a circular angle of 90° 17', a distance of 15.76 feet to an iron pipe, thence South 23° 25' East 45.62 feet to an iron pipe, thence South 37° 40' East 398.70 feet to an iron pipe, thence North 57° 21' West 165 feet, thence North 37° 40' West 143.36 feet to an iron pipe, thence North 62° 16' East 20.08 feet to an

iron pipe, thence North 37° 40' East 141.63 feet to an iron pipe, thence North 66° 52' East 706.46 feet to an iron pipe and the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
