**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That FRANK D. COHAN**

of 516 S. W. Main, Portland 4, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River, an unnamed stream and springs, a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation and domestic use for four houses under Permit No. 15024 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 25, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.223 cubic foot per second, being 0.148 c.f.s. from Tualatin River for irrigation; 0.065 c.f.s. from unnamed stream for irrigation; and 0.01 c.f.s. from spring for domestic use,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 20, Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The supplemental supply from the Tualatin River is to be used only when there is an insufficient quantity in the unnamed stream to supply ~~and shall~~ ~~the 0.065 c.f.s. from unnamed stream, as may be ordered by the proper state officer.~~

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
16.5 acres & Domestic in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 20  
Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

Being more specifically described as follows:

Domestic supply for 4 houses from spring in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
0.5 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  from river  
11.3 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  from river  
5.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  from creek

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
