**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** **N. V. STROMMEN**

of **Harbor**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

**North Fork of Tuttle Creek** for the purpose of  
 a tributary of **Chatco Creek**

irrigation and domestic use for one family, under Permit No. **16696** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **November 20, 1945**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.155 cubic foot per second, being 0.145 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use,**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the ~~XXXX~~ For domestic use: in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within H. Tuttle D.L.C. No. 38, Section 4; For irrigation: in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within H. Tuttle D.L.C. No. 38, Section 9, all being within Township **41 South, Range 13 West, W. M.** The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eighthieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre,

or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 5.9 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within H. Tuttle D.L.C. No. 38 Section 9**
  - 4.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within H. Tuttle D.L.C. No. 38**
  - 1.3 acre & Domestic in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within H. Tuttle D.L.C. No. 38 Section 4**
- Township 41 South, Range 13 West, W. M.**

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:  
 Beginning at a point **4.05 chain north and 30 chain east of the SW corner of section 4 T. 41S R. 13W of the Willamette meridian. Thence running south 18.77 chain thence east 31.95 chains, thence north 18.77 chain thence west 31.95 chain to the place of beginning containing sixty acres more or less.**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
