CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is To Certify**, That HERBERT F. AND ROVILLA HOKAMP

of Route 1, Box 360, Canby, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Milk Creek a tributary of Molalla River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 16847 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 15, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 7, Township 4 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

13.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
0.4 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 7  
Township 4 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe set in the west boundary of said Section 7, 899.1 feet north of the southwest corner of said section 7; thence South 56° 31' East a distance of 325.8 feet; thence South 80° 52' East 374.95 feet; thence North 83° 31' East 673.9 feet; thence South 68° 19' East 857.55 feet; thence south 6° 36' West 140 feet more or less; to the northwesterly boundary of that tract of land conveyed to Ernest C. Babcock and Josephine Babcock, his wife by deed recorded July 2, 1908 in book 104 at page 191, records of Clackamas County; thence southwesterly along said Babcock boundary 950.00 feet, more or less, to a point 28 rods due south of the section line between sections 7 and 18, which point is the re-entrant corner of said Babcock tract; thence West along the line of said Babcock tract 52 rods, more or less, to the southwest corner of Tract 1, desc. in the deed to Russel J. Rutherford et ux recorded March 10, 1947 in Vol. 386 at page 366; thence north 28 rods to the section line between sections 7 and 18; thence west 35 rods, more or less to the Southwest corner of said Section 7; thence North 899.1 feet to the place of beginning.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
