CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That RUSSELL J. RUTHERFORD
of Route 1, Box 127, Ganby, Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Milk Creek
a tributary of Molalla River for the purpose of
irrigation
under Permit No. 16847 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from March 15, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.21 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, Township 4 South, Range 2
East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

0.8 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
12.6 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
3.2 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 7

Township 4 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by
appropriator as follows:

The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, T. 4 S., R. 2 E., W.M., except the following described tract:
Beginning at an iron pipe set in the west boundary of said section 7, 899.1 feet
north of the southwest corner of said Section 7; running thence S. 56° 31' E. a
distance of 325.8 feet, thence S. 80° 52' E. 374.95 feet, thence N. 83° 31' E.
673.9 feet, thence S. 68° 19' E. 857.55 feet, thence S. 6° 36' W. 140 feet m. or
l. to the northwesterly boundary of that tract of land conveyed to Ernest C. Babcock
and Josephine Babcock, his wife, by deed recorded July 2, 1908 in Bk 104 at page 191
Deed Records of Clackamas County, thence southwesterly along said Babcock boundary
to the south line of said Section 7 thence westerly along said south section line
to the SW corner of said Section 7, thence northerly along the west line of said
Section 7, 899.1 feet to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
