CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That W. J. JEFFERY

of Route 1, Box 24-C, Philomath, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Mary's River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 16906 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.34 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the ~~the~~ Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 23, Township 11 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 2.6 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within W. Pearson D.L.C. No. 51
- 0.4 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within P. Henderson D.L.C. No. 50
- 4.4 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within W. Pearson D.L.C. No. 51
- 3.6 acres in Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
- 8.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within W. Pearson D.L.C. No. 51
- 8.2 acres in Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ S $\frac{1}{4}$)

Section 28
Township 11 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " shaft the Northwest corner of Perman Henderson D.L.C. #50, Township 11 South, Range 6 West Will. Mer., in Benton County, Oregon and running thence South 0° 08' East along the West line of said Claim 12.114 chains to an iron rod on the Westerly side of C. & E. branch of the Southern Pacific Co.'s railroad right-of-way, thence along the Westerly and Northerly line of said right-of-way to the West line of William Pearson D.L.C. #51 at a point 1.19 chains North of the Southwest corner of said Claim #51, thence North 31.874 chains, thence East 35.42 chains to the West line of said right-of-way, thence Southerly along the West line of said right-of-way to the North line of said Henderson Claim, thence South 89° 32' West 5.488 chains to the place of beginning, containing 94 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
