for the purpose of the irrigation of 10 acres of land, and stock use Permit No. 2198 of the State Engineer, and that said right to under the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 10th day of April, 1918 ut page 284 . on the ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates in the April 1, 1914 ; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not cubic wat per second. A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Ten acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Seven, Township Twenty-four South, Range Thirty-nine East of Willamette Meridian, in Malheur County, Oregon. The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to one-eightieth any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
