**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is To Certify, That** LEE V. AND WILLA J. OHMART AND  
RUDY F. AND LILLIAN CALABA

of 477 Court Street, Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Santiam River a tributary of Santiam River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. E-82 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 14, 1909

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.77 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 15, Township 9 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.  
A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within D.L.C. No. 83  
0.6 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within D.L.C. No. 82  
1.4 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within D.L.C. No. 83  
19.6 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within D.L.C. No. 82  
18.3 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within D.L.C. No. 83  
1.1 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within D.L.C. No. 83  
4.3 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within D.L.C. No. 82  
1.8 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within D.L.C. No. 82

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning on the Southerly line of the Daniel Durbin Donation Land Claim in Township 7 South, Range 2 and 3 West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, Oregon and in the center of Mill Creek at a point which is 210.00 feet N. 79° 07' E. from the angle corner on the Southerly line of said Claim; thence N. 79° 07' E. along the Southerly line of said claim 1769.77 feet; thence N. 10° 04' W. 1733.28 feet to the North line of lands conveyed in Volume 320, Page 339, Deed Records for said County and State; thence S. 89° 00' W. along said North line 1028.60 feet to the East line of Melrose Addition; thence S. 0° 56' W. along the East line of said Melrose Addition 825.00 feet to the Southeast corner thereof; thence S. 89° 23' W. along the South line of said Addition 1450.00 feet, more or less, to the center of said Mill Creek; thence Southeasterly along the center of said Mill Creek to the place of beginning, and containing 75.30 acres of land, more or less. Save and except a

strip of land 200.00 feet in width and containing 5.70 acres of land, more or less, same being a portion of the proposed Salem By-pass Road.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
