## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is To Certify, That FREDERICK B. HILLER

of Newberg , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unmaned stream (outlet of Skookum Lake) a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of

under Permit No. 14895 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 30, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.225 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NWL SEL, as projected within Geo. Alpin D.L.C.

No. 64, Section 32, Township 3 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.2 acres in NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, as projected within Etiene Lucier D.L.C. No. 65 0.4 acre in Lot 4 (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>)
2.2 acres in Lot 5 (SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>)
0.1 acre in SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, as projected within Geo. Alpin D.L.C. No. 64 0.2 acre in NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, as projected within Geo. Alpin D.L.C.
