CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That MARGARET D. HILLER

of Star Route, Newberg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream (outlet of Skookum Lake), a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 14895 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 30, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.675 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Etienne Lucier D.L.C. No. 65, Section 32, Township 3 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

16.7 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Etienne Lucier D.L.C. No. 65
9.5 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Etienne Lucier D.L.C. No. 65
0.3 acre in Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
2.8 acres in Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
5.3 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Geo. Alpin D.L.C. No. 64
13.6 acres in Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
10.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Geo. Alpin D.L.C. No. 64
16.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Etienne Lucier D.L.C. No. 65
21.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Geo. Alpin D.L.C. No. 64
0.6 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Geo. Alpin D.L.C. No. 64
15.6 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Etienne Lucier D.L.C. No. 65
18.2 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Etienne Lucier D.L.C. No. 65
Section 32
Township 3 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe in the center of Section 32, in Township 3 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon, thence South 41 degrees 25 minutes East, 1721.33 feet to an iron pipe; thence North 72 degrees 25 minutes East, 1004.38 feet to an iron pipe; thence North 1 degree 27 minutes West, 936.64 feet to the Southerly line of the County Road leading from St. Paul to Newberg; thence North 65 degrees 26 minutes West, along said Southerly line, 1631.14 feet; thence North 44 degrees 27 minutes West along the center line of the above mentioned County Road, 1920.39 feet; thence South 45 degrees 33 minutes West, perpendicular to the above mentioned center line of said County Road, 1972.30 feet; thence South 44 degrees 27 minutes East, parallel to the aforementioned center line of said County Road, 2640.00 feet to the South line of that certain tract of land

described in Volume 205, Page 335 of the Marion County, Oregon, Deed Records; thence North 83 degrees 40 minutes East along said South Line, 50.06 feet to an angle in said line; thence North 41 degrees 50 minutes East, 297.00 feet; thence North 26 degrees 35 minutes East, 165.00 feet; thence North 0 degrees 30 minutes West 892.32 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 156.27 acres of land all being situated in Section 32, and being a part of the Etlene Lucier and George Alpin Donation Land Claims.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
