## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is To Certify, That C. D. ZEHRUIG

of Myrtle Creek , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Myrtle Creek a tributary of South Umpous River for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 16953 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed aates from April 24. 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.174 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWL SEL, Section 22, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.3 acres in NW1 SE1 10.6 acres in SW1 SE1 Section 22 Township 29 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of the county road seven and fifteen hundredths chains north and thirty-seven and twenty-eight hundredths chains east from the corner of sections 21, 22, 27 and 28 in Township 29, South of Range 5 West of the Willamette Meridian, thence North thirty-three degrees East twenty and twelve hundredths chains to a point marked by a stone 4 x 6 x 10, set in the ground ten links west of the center of the county road from which a white oak tree ten inches in diameter marked x bears north fifty-seven degrees west thirteen links; thence east twelve and twenty-seven hundredths chains to a stone from which an ash tree twelve inches in diameter bears south seventy nine degrees east seventy-two links: thence south three and sixty hundredths chains to the center of north Myrtle Creek; thence following the meanders of said creek south fifty-four degrees West eight and eighty-three hundredths chains; thence south twenty-six decrees East one chain; thence south thirty-seven degrees west four and forty-five hundredths chains; thence south fifty-four degrees west five and fifteen hundredths chains; thence North eightyeight degrees west three and fifty-eight hundredths chains; thence south thirty degrees west one and thirty-one hundredths chains; thence west six and thirty-five hundredths chains to the point of beginning, containing 20 acres, more or less, all in Douglas County, Oregon.
