CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That C. R. AND EDITH P. MC KAY

of 1399 Juniper Street, Coos Bay , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

an unnamed creek a tributary of Kentuck Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation and domestic use for one family under Permit No. 15294 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 8, 1942

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.018 cubic foot per second, being 0.008 c.f.s. for irrigation, and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL SEL, Section 34, Township 24 South, Hange 12 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be limited still further to a total diversion of not to exceed 0.008 c.f.s. for irrigation,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.6 acre and domestic use in SE; SE; Section 34 Township 24 South, Range 12 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Commencing at a point on the Township line 6 chains and 20 links West from the Southeast corner of Section 34, Township 24 South, Range 12, W.W.M. and run thence West on said Township line 13 chains and 80 links on variation of 19° 30' East; thence North on right angle 4 chains; thence North 21° 30' East 1.54 chains; thence North 42° 45' East 0.90 chains; thence North 60° East 1.48 chains; thence North 73° East 1.87 chains; thence North 20° East 0.72 chains; thence North 58° 45' East 1.56 chains; thence North 60° 15' East 1.36 chains; thence North 11° 15' East 0.75 chains; thence North 26° West 0.68 chains; thence North 63° West 0.41 chains; thence North 12° 15' East 1.29 chains; thence North 11° 45' East 0.87 chains; thence North 21.° 15' East 0.77 chains; thence East 23° South 7.36 chains; thence South on variation 19° 30' East 12.15 chains to place of beginning, containing 14.666 acres, more or less, all in the SEt of Section 34, Township 24 South, Range 12 W.W.M., also free use of roadway leading from County Road up Kentuck Slough to Creek; also the starting point is 20 chains West on Section line and 4 chains North on a 1/16 line from the Southeast corner of Section 34, Township 24 South, Range 12 W.W.M. starting point; thence North 212° East 1.54 chains; North 42 3/4° East 0.92 chains; North 50° East 1.48 chains; North 75° East 1.87 chains; North 20° East 0.72 chains; North 53.75° East 1.56 chains; North 60to East 1.36 chains; North 11to East 0.75 chains; North 20° West 0.68 chains; North 63° West 0.41 chains; North 121° East 1.29 chains; North 11.75° East 0.87 chains; North 214° East 1.10 chains; North 26.75° East 0.81 chains; North 13° East 0.95 chains; North 28° East 1.39 chains; North 18° West 0.77 chains; North 0° 30' East 1.76 chains; West 8 chains on 1/16 line; thence South 16

chains on 1/16 line to place of beginning, containing 9 acres, more or less. The above lines follow up the center of a creek, excepting last 24 chains. All situated in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section $3l_t$, Township 24 South, Range 12 West of Willamette Meridian.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. \cdot
