## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is To Certify, That LUCY C. AND ROY BRANTON

of Route 2, Box 111-A, Silverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Silver Creek

a tributary of Pudding River irrigation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 17877 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 6, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL NWL, as projected within P. Cox D.L.C. No. 44, Section 34, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre in NEt NWt, as projected within P. Cox D.L.C. No. 14.
9.4 acres in SEt NWt, as projected within P. Cox D.L.C. No. 44.
2.4 acres in SEt NWt, as projected within L. Davis D.L.C. No. 46
Section 34
Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Commencing at a point which is North 15.26 chains from the South West corner of a tract of land described in Certificate of Title #11, first registered June 25, 1909, in Section 34, Township 6 South, Range 1 West of Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, Oregon; said point is also on the East boundary of a 20-acre tract of land formerly ownded by Zella Davis described in Volume 76 on page 580, Deed Records for Marion County, Oregon; thence North 13.31 chains to the North East corner of said 20-acre tract of land, which is about the center of the channel of Silver Creek; thence up said Silver Creek meandering the channel as follows, to-wit: North 79° 23' East 3.32 chains; thence South 53° 15' East 8.57 chains; South 6° 30' East 2.56 chains South 84° 33' East 3.82 chains; thence leaving said creek and running South 4.64 chains; thence South 77° 1' West 1.66 chains; thence South 14' East .81 chain to the North East corner of a nine-acre tract of land deeded to P. O. Henderson, March 17th, 1919; thence South 89° 30' West along the North boundary of 9-acre tract of land, 12.56 chains to the place of beginning; being situated in the Peter Cox Donation Land Claim, in Township 6 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein accoribed.
