CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PETE CHECKWICK

of 3917 S.E. Aldercrest Road, Portland, State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Kellogg Creek

a tributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

a swimming pool and irrigation under Permit No. 1844 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 29. 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.014 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for pool, and 0.004 c.f.s. for irrigation,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL NEL, as projected within J. Kellogg D.L.C. No. 53, Section 1, Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.3 acre and Swimming Pool in SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ as projected within J. Kellogg D.L.C. No. 53

Section 1

Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:
All that portion of Lot 4, Block V, RESURVEY OF MILWAUKIE PARK, which lies southeasterly of a line running from a point on Aldercrest Road, which point is 100 feet from the most southerly corner of said Lot 4 to a point on the Kellogg Creek, which point is 100 feet from the most easterly corner of said Lot 4.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
