CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Box 355, Roseburg , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

South Unpqua River a tributary of Unpqua River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 18628 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from February 17, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount artually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEL NEL Section 16, Township 28 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.3 acres in NEt NEt 12.4 acres in NWt NEt Section 16

Towiship 28 South, Range & West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

"Commencing at a point 12.19 chains South of the Northwest corner of Section 16, Township 28, South of Range 6 West, thence East to a point in the center of the main channel of the South Umpqua River, thence in a southeasterly direction along the center of the main channel of the river and following its windings to a point 20 chains due South of the North boundary of said section 16, thence West along a line parallel with and 20 chains distant from the North line of said Section 16, to the West boundary of the Section, thence North 7.83 chains to the place of beginning containing about 60 acres and all being situated in Douglas County, State of Oregon".

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
