CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK H. PLAISTED

of Route 3, Box 478, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of McKay Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18726 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.625 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, Township 2 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.2 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
20.6 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
13.9 acres in Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
0.3 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 30

Township 2 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Following is description of tract to Charles Nitchman (V.117, P.255) The NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 30, T. 2 N., R. 2 W., W.M., containing 158.90 acres. Also the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and Government lots 1, 2 and 3 of Sec. 30, T 2N, R 2W, W.M., containing 131.33 acres. Also beginning at the NE Cor. SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 30, thence S 6 chains; thence W. 11.50 chains; thence N. 6 chains to the N. line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence E. on said N. line 11.50 chs. to the place of beginning, containing 6.90 acres. Excepting from above tract 2 acres conveyed as a cemetery, Book 26, Page 596. Also excepting 10 acres conveyed to Caleb Hall, Book 51, page 336. Also excepting tract conveyed to John Roberts, Book "k", page 317, containing not less than 20 acres. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
