## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** A. GUNTHER

of Route 3, Box 157, Oregon City, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Canfield Creek, tributary of Beaver Creek, tributary of Willamette River, to be appropriated under Application No. 23607, Permit No. 18804,

for the purposes of  
irrigation,

under Reservoir Permit No. R-976 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 1, 1949,

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 6.5 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 9, SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within R. Canfield D.L.C.No. 59, Tp. 3 South, R. 2 East, W. M.
