**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** BERNICE A. RHODES

of Route 2, Box 400, Oswego, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring Creek and reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-23691, Permit No. R-970 a tributary of Lake Oswego for the purpose of supplemental irrigation under Permit No. 18730 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.213 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 5, Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-970; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

17.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 5

Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of the Boones Ferry County Road, N 26° 30' E. 250 feet and N 22° 10' E 71 feet from the  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner on the south line of section 5, Twp 2 S., R 1 E, W.M.; thence following the center line of said county road, N 22° 10' E 164 feet; thence N 45° 39' E 90 feet; thence N 33° 53' E 140 feet; thence N. 16° 20' E 103.78 feet thence N 42° 45' E 113.4 feet; thence N. 28° 08' E 149.3 feet; thence N 12° 24' E 246.2 feet; thence N. 67° 08' E 167.1 feet; thence N. 34° 34' E 106.2 feet to the north line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said section 5; thence S. 89° 30' 30" E a distance of 532.9 feet to the NE corner of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence S. 0° 03' 30" E a distance of 1316.86 feet to the SE corner of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence S 89° 31' W along the south line of said section 5, 571.36 feet; thence N 0° 10' W 234.96 feet; thence S 89° 31' W 637.57 feet to the place of beginning, except the north and east 16.5 feet thereof.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
