CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That R. M. COOLEY

of 810 N. Water Street, Silverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Silver Creek

a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 16780 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 14, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Peter Cox D.L.C. No. 44, Section 34, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Leander Davis D.L.C. No. 46
6.8 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Leander Davis D.L.C. No. 46
Section 33
2.8 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Leander Davis D.L.C. No. 46
4.4 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Leander Davis D.L.C. No. 46
Section 34
Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Commencing on the N. boundary of the DLC of Leander S. Davis and wife, at a point which is 13.25 chs. W. of the NW cor. of a 160-acre tract of land deeded by the said Davis and wife to John C. Carey; thence S. parallel to the W. boundary of the aforesaid 160-acre tract 26.13 chains to the N. side of the S. P. R. R. Co.'s R/W; thence S. 59° 30' W. along said R/W 11.22 chs., thence N. parallel to the E. side of the present conveyed tract, 31.83 chs. to a point in the N. boundary of the aforesaid DLC, the same being at a point in the S. boundary of a 9.85-acre tract of land deeded by H. C. Steen, et al, to Jennie Benson on the 31st day of January, 1912, deed being recorded in Marion County Records Book of Deeds, Vol. 121, on page 20; this point is also 9.67 chs. W. of the above commencing point; thence N. 8.70 chs., thence N. 57° E. 1.49 chs., thence S. 82° 45' E. 4.24 chs., thence S. 2° 5' E. 3.36 chs., thence S. 42° 20' E. 3.20 chs., thence N. 84° 15' E. 2.00 chs.; thence E. 90 links; thence S. 80° W. 1.12 chains; thence S. 3.27 chains to the place of beginning, situated in Marion County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
