CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That DONALD L. OLSON

of Route 2, Box 55, Aurora, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Pudding River a tributary of Molalla River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17910 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 14, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.352 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within A. T. Minier D.L.C. No. 60, and in Lot 3 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), all being within Section 25, Township 4 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acre in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within A. T. Minier D.L.C. No. 60
3.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within A. T. Minier D.L.C. No. 60
14.6 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within A. T. Minier D.L.C. No. 60
0.8 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within A. T. Minier D.L.C. No. 60
9.6 acres in Lot 3 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)

Section 25
Township 4 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at the SW cor. of the D. W. Oglesby's homestead, being also the SW cor. of Lot 3, in Sec. 25, T. 4 S., R. 1 W., W.M., thence N on the E boundary of A. T. Minier's DLC #60, a distance of 5.50 chs. to the right bank of Pudding R; thence up said stream N 61° 30' W. 3.70 chs., thence N. 50° 30' W. 5.00 chs.; thence N. 56° 30' W. 6.55 chs., thence N. 9° 30' E 12.65 chs., thence N. 87° 45' W 4.00 chs., thence S. 52° 15' W 12.45 chs., thence S 2° 30' E. 23.85 chs., thence S. 73° E 1.50 chs., thence N 50° E 14.70 chs., thence N 82° 30' E 5.65 chains; thence S 38° E 7.90 chs. to a point on the E line of said A. T. Minier's DLC; thence N 1.50 chs. to the place of beginning, containing 41.41 acres, more or less.

Also the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25, T. 4 S., R. 1 W., containing 80 acres, more or less, save and except therefrom 2.56 acres deeded by John Frank Campan and Lillie H. Campau, his wife to Charles M. Barnes on the 12th day of June 1909, deed to which is found of record in book 109 at page 481, of the deed records of Clackamas Co., Ore., containing 118.85 acres, more or less, according to the Government survey thereof.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
