CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That M. W. BAILEY

Philomath , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Norton Creek and two unnamed streams, a tributary of Mary's River

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 18876 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 21. 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.330 cubic foot per second, being 0.16 c.f.s. from Norton Creek; 0.08 c.f.s. from west stream; and 0.09 c.f.s. from southwest stream,

. or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE NVL, NWL NWL and in Lot 5 (SWL NWL), Section 11, Township 11 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.4 acres in NE% NW%

9.3 acres in NWI NWI

8.6 acres in Lot 5 (SW2 NW2)
4.4 acres in Lot 4 (SE2 NW2)

Section 11

Township 11 South, Range 7 West, W. M. Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

The north half of the northwest quarter and Lots Four and Five, EXCEPTING the following; Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot Five and run thence north along the east line of said Lot Five a distance of 276 feet; thence west parallel with the south line of said Lot Five to the West line of said lot; thence south along the west line of said Lot Five 276 feet to the southwest corner of said lot; thence east on the south line of said Lot Five to the place of beginning, all in Section Eleven, Township Eleven South, Range Seven West of the Willamette Meridian.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
