CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That MRS. HAROLD SNYDER

of Azalea, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cow Creek a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19033 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 24, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-seventieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 7
Township 32 South, Range 4 West, W. M.
4.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 12
Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

A tract of land containing 5.24 acres situate in the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 12 Township 32 South Range 5 West, Willamette Meridian Douglas County, Oregon being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the quarter corner on East boundary line of said Section 12, running thence west a distance of 450 feet; thence North 23°54' West across Cow Creek a distance of 223 feet; thence North 66°04' East 37 feet; thence North 45°35' East 189 feet; thence North 49°10' East 164.8 feet; thence East across Cow Creek a distance of 244.6 feet; thence South a distance of 459 feet to the place of beginning

Also a tract of land containing 14.76 acres situated in the South half of the Northwest quarter of Section 7, Township 32 South Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian, being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the quarter corner of the west boundary line of said Section 7, thence running North a distance of 459 feet; thence North 85°30' East following a certain fence a distance of 1444.4 feet thence South a distance of 432 feet to a point in a fence line; thence South 84°26' West following said fence line a distance of 1444.4 feet to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
