CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That B. J. WOODWARD

of Route 1, Box 115, Milino, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Molalla River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 20207 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 28, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.237 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, Township 4 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

14.8 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
1.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 20
2.4 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
0.5 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 29

Township 4 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning in the center of the Oregon City and Molalla road; 476.85 feet west of the northeast corner of the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of Section 20, Township 4 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian; running thence West 843.15 feet to the northwest corner of the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of Section 20 in said Township and Range; thence at right angles South 20.00 chains to Section line; thence at right angles East 843.00 feet, more or less, to the center of the Oregon City and Molalla road; thence North 2 deg. 6' West to the place of beginning, containing 23.60 acres, more or less. Except a tract of land in the northwest corner thereof heretofore conveyed to C. T. Sievers and Mina Sievers by deed recorded in Book 221, at Page 425 of the Deed Records of Clackamas County, Oregon.

Also: A tract of land located in the Harrison Wright Claim No. 38, Township 4 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian, being more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point in the north boundary of said claim that is North 89 deg 37' West 676.50 feet distant from the northeast corner of said claim, from said beginning point thence continuing along said claim boundary North 89 deg 37' West to the right bank of the Molalla River; thence up stream, following the said right bank to a point that bears South 41 deg. 48' East from the place of beginning heretofore described; thence North 41 deg. 48' West, following the northwesterly boundary of the

tract of land described in that certain conveyance from Elizabeth Adcins to J. D. and Hulda French and recorded on May 24, 1907 in Book 99, Page 354, Record of Deeds for Clackamas County, Oregon, to the place of beginning of the tract herein described, including all the riparian rights now owned by Clackamas County adjacent thereto, excepting therefrom the rights of the public in and to the 60 foot right of way of the Oregon City-Silverton State Highway.

Also: Beginning at a point in the north boundary of the Harrison Wright Claim No. 38, Township 4 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian that is West 483.42 feet distant from the northeast corner of said claim; thence South 1 deg. 24' East 41.16 feet along the Oregon City Silverton State Highway; thence South 19 deg. 17' East 75.78 feet to a point of curve; thence along a 6 deg. curve to the left, thru a central angle of 12 deg. 30', a distance of 208.33 feet to a point of tangent; thence South 31 deg. 47' East 37.12 feet to a point of curve; thence along a 200 deg. curve to the right, thru a central angle of 122 deg. 30', a distance of 61.25 feet to a point of tangent; thence North 89 deg. 17' West 117.52 feet for a terminus under the northerly approach to Wrights Bridge.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
