CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT.

This Is to Certify, That JAMES F. HANHART

of Milino , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Milk Creek

a tributary of Holalla River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 19604 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from July 6, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.013 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL NEL, Section 17, Township 4 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre in NEL SEL
Section 17
Township 4 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:
Part of the East half of the East half of Section 17, in T. 4 S. R. 2 E. of W.M.
Beginning at a point 60 feet north and 271.3 feet west of the one quarter section corner between Sections 16, and 17, in T. 4 S., R. 2 E. of W.M.; running thence west 125 feet; thence South 48° west 315.8 feet; thence east 360 feet; thence north 211.3 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1.18 acres, more or less. Situate in Clackamas County.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
