CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED G. ALBERTUS

of Box 371, C.V. Route, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 17629 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from March 24, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.095 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWL NEL, Section 16, Township 28 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall befurther limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.6 acres in NWA NEA Section 16 Township 28 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point from which the N. W. Corner of Sect. 16, T. 28 S., R. 6 W., Will. Mer. Bears W. 2972.3' & N. 804.5 ft., thence running N. 0° 15' E. 37756' thence S. 89° 45' E. 906.6' to center of S. Umpqua River, Thence S. E. Tirection along said center of river and running N. 89° 45' W. 1346.6 to place of beginning. Ten acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
