under Permit No. **U-296** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **Angust 8, 1949**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 5.0 cubic feet per second, being 2.0 c.f.s. from Well No. 2, and 3.0 c.f.s. from Well No. 3,

Wells are or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The resident control located in the: Well No. 2 - NE; SE; Section 15; Well No. 3: NW; NE; Section 22, all being within Township 1 North, Range 39 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Sections 14, 15 and 22 Township 1 North, Range 39 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
