CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That KENNETH HALL

of Enterprise, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Wallowa River, for the purpose of domestic use in tourist camp (12 cabins), including irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre laws and gardens for each cabin under Permit No. 18423 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 25, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 28, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Hall property:
NE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 29
Township 3 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

Bacon property:
NW 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 28
Township 3 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:
Hall: Beginning at a point on the east line of Section 29 in Township 3 South, Range 45 East, Willamette Meridian, Oregon, which point is South 0 deg. 31' west 680 feet, more or less, from the northeast corner of said Section 29, being the northeast corner of Block 1 of Panorama Park of Wallowa Park Camp of the Methodist Camp Ground Association, (plat not recorded), thence south 89 deg. 04' west 584 feet, more or less, to the east line of the right of way of the Pacific Power and Light Co., as shown on said plat, thence south 23 deg 32" west along said right of way, 735 feet to the south line of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of said Section 29, thence north 39 deg 04" east along said south line of said northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of said Section 29 to the east line of said Section 29, which point is 44 feet south 0 deg. 31" east of the Southeast corner of Block 5 of said Panorama Park of Wallowa Park Camp of the Methodist Camp Ground Association, (plat not recorded), thence north 0 deg. 31" east along the east line of said Section 29, 664 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning and containing seven acres, more or less, and being situate in the east half of the northeast quarter of the northeast

quarter of Section 29, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, Willamette Meridian, Oregon.
Excepting therefrom a tract heretofore sold to Hulburd.

Bacon: Commencing at a point 200' N. of the S.W. corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of
Section 28 in Township 3 South of Range 45 East of the Willamette Meridian in Wallowa
county, Oregon, running thence E. 100'; thence N. 50'; thence W. 100'; thence S. 50'
to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
