CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

Francis and Elanor Hopson, Claud and Charlotte Dickensen, H. T. and Sadie Benson, and E. G. and Thelma M. Delyria, of Joseph, State of Oregon, have made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Wallows Miver, for the purpose of domestic use in 14 cabins and one restaurant, including the irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre domestic leam and garden, per cabin, under Permit No. 18425 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 25, 1948; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW2, NW2, Section 28, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriators as follows:

HAMILTON:

Beginning at the northeast corner of the northeast quarter of section 29, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, of the Willamette Meridian, running thence due west 210 feet; thence south 660 feet; thence east 210 feet; thence North 660 feet to the place of beginning.

HOPSON:

Beginning at a point 258 feet North of the Southwest corner of that certain tract described in Book 43 at page 73, Deed Racords of Wallowa County, Oregon, thence North 88 feet; thence East 126 feet, thence Southwesterly 68 feet, thence West 82 feet, more or less to the place of beginning, all in Section 29, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, of Willamette Meridian, Wallowa County, Oregon.

DICKENSON:

Beginning at a point 75 feet North of the Southwest corner of that certain tract described in Book 43 of Deeds at page 73, Deed Records of Wallows County, Oregon, thence North 183 feet, thence East 82 feet, thence Southwesterly 187 feet more or less to the point of beginning, all in Section 29, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, of Willamette Meridian, Wallows County Oregon.

BENSON:

Beginning at a point on the section line which is 483 feet South of the Northeast corner of Section 29, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, of Willamette Meridian, thence South 177 feet, thence West 210 feet, thence North 75 feet, thence Northeasterly along the center line of the road thereon, a distance of 113 feet, thence East 162 feet, more or less to the point of beginning.

DE LYRIA:

Beginning at a point on the section line, 243 feet South of the Northeast corner of Section 29, Township 3 South, Range 45, East of Willamette Meridian, thence South 240 feet, thence West 162 feet, thence in a northeasterly direction 287 feet more or less to the point of beginning, all in Section 29, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, of the Willamette Meridian, Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
