CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT -

This Is to Certify. That GALEN W. BAY

of Route 1, Box 102, Rogue River , State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Mays Creek, a tributary of Evans Creek, a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 21.685 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 6, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.188 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL SWL, Section 32, Township 34 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second peracre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 42 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 15.0 acres in SWE SEL Section 32 Township 34 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
