CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under reservoir permits)

This is to Certify, That MILTON B. SEXTON

of Ontario, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Snow Shed of Dry Creek Pass, tributary of Malheur River

for the purpose of the irrigation of lands described in Permit No. 2198, certificate of water right recorded in Vol. 3, Page 2041, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and stock use

under Reservoir Permit No. 307 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1 at page 284, on the 10th day of April, 1918; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 7, 1914

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 10 acre feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 7, Tp. 24 S, R. 39 E., W. M.
