CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EARL GOREE

of Route 2, Box 633-B, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of The Canyon & Reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-27410, Per. No. R-1395 a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation, fish culture and power under Permit No. 21650 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 7, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 second foot of water, being 0.05 c.f.s. for irrigation; 0.90 c.f.s. for power; and 0.05 c.f.s. for fish culture,

or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1395,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Power in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
4.0 acres and fish culture in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 29
Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

The East 30 acres of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 29, Township 36 South, Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years' notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 47-508, Oregon Code 1930.
