CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JEROME R. SMITH

of 1033 Reddy Avenue, Medford, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tin Cup Creek and Saylor Gulch, tributary of South Fork Galice Creek, a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of mining and domestic use under Permit No. 18176 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from Mar 17, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 6.0 cubic feet per second, being 2.985 c.f.s. for mining, and 0.015 c.f.s. for domestic use from each source,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, all being within Township 35 South, Range 8 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 10

Township 35 South, Range 8 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Mining from Quit Claim Mining Deed, from J. W. Fowler to Jerome R. Smith, et al, Josephine County Mining Conveyance Records, Volume 13, page 601, :
LUCKY DAY PLACER MINING CLAIM, Location Notice of which was recorded June 30, 1920 in Volume 24, Mining Records of Josephine County, Oregon, at Page 455;
MOLONEY PLACER MINING CLAIM, Location Notice of which was recorded June 20, 1921 in Volume 25, Mining Records of Josephine County, Oregon, at Page 166; and
SAILOR JACK PLACER MINING CLAIM, Location Notice of which is recorded in Volume 25, Mining Records of Josephine County, Oregon, at Page 568 thereof;
Together with all ditches, water rights out of Saylor Jack Creek, pipes, giants and sluices appendant and appurtenant thereto; Reference being hereby made to the books, pages and numbers of recording of said claims for a more perfect description of the same.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
