CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under reservoir permits)

This is to Certify, That THE CITY OF WESTON
of Weston, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to store the
waters of Pine Creek, a tributary of Walla Walla River

for the purposes of
municipal supply to be appropriated under permit No. 2222, certificate of water
right recorded in Vol. 3, Page 2091, State Record of Water Right certificates

under Reservoir Permit No. 301 of the State Engineer, and that said right to
store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly
confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of
record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1,
at page 296, on the 2nd day of August, 1918; that the
priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 8, 1914

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the
purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 37 acre feet.

The reservoir is located in Sections 35 and 36, Tp. 4 N., R. 35 E., W. N.
