CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J.E. COLEMAN

of Route 2, Box 378, Molalla , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Milk Creek

a tributary of Molalla River

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 15582 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 14, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.115 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE¹₄ SE¹₄, Section 1, Township 5 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.2 acres in NE SE2 5.0 acres in SE2 SE2 Section 1 Township 5 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of Milk Creek, where the same now crosses the east boundary of Section 1, T. 5 S., R. 2 E., W. M., thence running north along said Section line 400.00 feet; thence N. 59° 30° W. 4.08 feet to an iron pipe; thence north 27.50 chains; thence west 8.50 chains; thence south 19.50 chains to the center of Milk Creek; thence in an easterly direction along the center line of Milk Creek to the place of beginning, containing 25.00 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
