CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ESTATE OF BERNARD KEMPER, DECEASED

of Route 2, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Dairy Creek, a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18210 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 17, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.573 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. When in the distribution of water it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices, the appropriator or his successor in interest will be required to install these so as not to restrict the natural channel of the stream or interfere with the flow of the water therein. The location and plans of these structures shall be approved by the State Engineer prior to construction. The appropriation shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

14.8 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Richard Arthur D.L.C. No. 43
2.9 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 16

16.2 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Richard Arthur D.L.C. No. 43
11.9 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 17

Township 1 North, Range 3 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a stone on the E. line of and 11.215 chs. N. of the SE corner of Richard Arthur D.L.C. No. 43, thence N. 89° 19' W. 30.63 chs. to a yew post, thence S. 17.6 chs., more or less, to the center of the West Fork of Dairy Creek, thence down said creek to its junction with the East Fork of Dairy Creek, thence up the East Fork of Dairy Creek to the E. line of D.L.C. No. 43, thence N. on said E. line 5.2 chs., more or less, to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
