CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LARRY BARNES

of 11th and Grove Streets, Boise , State of Idaho , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Green Canyon,

a tributary of Evans Creek irrigation and stock use

.for the purpose of

under Permit No. 19129 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 5, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL SWL, Section 11, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:
