CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN W. STEWART

of Route 3, Box 386-B, Medford, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 20778 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 27, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.012 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.012 c.f.s.,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 5
Township 38 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point at the NE corner of Lot 3 of Gold Range Orchards, in Jackson County, Oregon, according to the official plat thereof; now of record; thence W., to the easterly line of the Pacific Highway; thence Southeasterly, along the easterly line of the Pacific Highway, to the point of intersection with the E. line of said Lot 3; thence N., along the E. line of said Lot, to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
