CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROBERT J. SUGDEN

of Route 1, Box 299, Gold Hill, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of domestic use for one family, including irrigation of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ ac. lawn & garden under Permit No. 21811 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 1, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 26
Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 36 of Champlin's Subdivision in Section 25, 26, 35 and 36 in Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W. M., Jackson County, Oregon, according to the official plat thereof now of record; run thence Southwesterly along the easterly line of said lot to the Southeast corner thereof; thence Westerly 85 feet along the Northerly line of the Pacific Highway; thence Northerly to the North line of said lot to point, 142 feet Westerly from the Northeast corner thereof; thence Easterly, along said Northerly line 142 feet to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
