CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)

This is to Certify, That THE C & O LUMBER COMPANY

of Brookings, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the
waters of Ferry Creek, a tributary of Chetco River

for the purpose of manufacturing and domestic supply, to be
stored under Reservoir permit No. 408, certificate of water right recorded in Vol.3, Page
2071, State Record of Water Right Certificates
under Permit No. 1740 of the State Engineer, and that said right to
the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and
duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered
of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1,
at page 296, on the 2nd day of August, 1918; that the priority of
the right hereby confirmed dates from August 22, 1913; that the amount of
water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid,
is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not
exceed 3.00 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby
confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put
to beneficial use, is as follows: Lot Five (SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄) of Section Six, Township Forty-
one South, Range Thirteen West of Willamette Meridian, in Curry County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the
lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty
years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference
right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for
power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
