CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **BEND SAND and GRAVEL COMPANY**

of **Bend** , State of **Oregon** , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Deschutes River** a tributary of **Columbia River** for the purpose of **manufacturing** under Permit No. **14551** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **August 19, 1940**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.25 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, W. M.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Blocks 49 and 50, Townsite of Laidlaw
(now known as Tumalo) and being within
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 31,
T. 16 S., R. 12 E., W.M.**

NOTE: This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion of water approved by an order of the State Engineer entered July 24, 1953, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530 and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Bend Sand and Gravel Company and recorded at Page 13819, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

All sand and dirt is to be settled out of the water in settling basins before water is allowed to flow back into the stream.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
