## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That im. H. STEEN, W. LOWELL STEEN, EVA STEEN SHANNON

of Milton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dry Creek

a tributary of Pine Creek and Walla Walla River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 17386 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from March 25, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.54 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWL SWL, Section 23, Township 5 North, Range 35 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-sixtieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any 30-day period and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation-season from April 1, to October 1,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.0 acres in SW1 SW1
19.2 acres in NW1 SW1
5.4 acres in SW1 NW1
Section 23
Township 5 North, Range 35 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
