CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That FRANCIS L. & AUDREY T. BARCLAY

of Alsea, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream a tributary of Alsea River for the purpose of domestic supplies, including the irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre domestic lands hereinafter described, for one family State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 25, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 36, Township 13 South, Range 10 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 5
Section 36
Township 13 South, Range 10 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Copy of deed dated June 10, 1946, and given to Lee R. Jones by Raymond Laudenbeck and Lena Laudenbeck, husband and wife

The following described property in the County of Lincoln and State of Oregon; That part of Section 36, Township 13 South, Range 10 West, W. M., described as follows: Beginning at an iron pipe which is South 459.75 feet and East 2522.67 feet from the meander corner in the West line of Section 36, Township 13 South, Range 10 West, W. M., and on the North bank of the Alsea River; thence South 25° 30' West 245.23 feet to an iron pipe; thence North 67 West 77.2 feet; thence North 23° 00' East 276 feet more or less to the Southerly line of the Alsea Highway; thence Easterly on the Southerly line of said Highway 89 feet more or less to a point which is North 25° 30' East from the point of beginning; thence South 25° 30' West 31.03 feet more or less to the point of beginning. Also all land lying between the Southerly prolongation of the Easterly and Westerly line of said tract to the high water mark on the North side of the Alsea River.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
