## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That JESSE L. HARRIS

of Box 110. Wolf Creek , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Wolf Creek

a tributary of Grave Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation under Permie No. 19386 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been verfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes asoresaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NET NWT. Section 22. Township 33 South. Range 6 West. W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre ingated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 42 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 ar. Test spor vul 22 p45 0.4 acres in NEt NWt Section 22 Township 33 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
