CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That H. E. SOWELL

of Box 750, Cave Junction, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Linkhart Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-27746, Permit No. R-1450, & an unnamed swamp, a tributary of East Fork Illinois River for the purpose of irrigation and fish culture under Permit No. 21850 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 20, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet of stored water only for irrigation, and 0.30 cubic feet per second for fish culture,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to $3\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet ~~per year~~ during the irrigation season of each year and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre feet per year during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10 acres and fish culture in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 28

Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:

A parcel of land situated in the North half of the Northeast quarter of Section 28 in Township 39 South Range 8 West of the Willamette Meridian, as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter of said Section 28 and running thence East 560 feet to a point in the center line of the Rockydale Road, said point being the true point of beginning; thence North 6° 22' West 316.5 feet; along the center line of the Rockydale Road; thence North 14° 25' East 171.13 feet; along the center line of Rockydale Road; thence North 31° 24' East 429.48 feet along said Road; thence North 47° 46' East 560 feet more or less to the center line of the East Fork Illinois River; thence Southeasterly along the approximately center line of said river to a point on the South line of the North half of the Northeast quarter of said Section 28 which bears East 945.5 feet from the true point of beginning; thence West to the true point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
