CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WALTER R. HOLMES

of Route 1, Box 164, Riddle, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cow Creek a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 22713 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 5, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.086 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W. M.,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-seventieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 19
Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:

Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner between Sec. 19 & 30 T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W. M., running thence N. 20.90 chains to the SW corner of the John Yokum D.L.C. in said T. & R., said claim being numbered 49. Thence E. 10 chains; thence S. 20.90 chains; thence W. 10 chains; to the place of beginning containing 20.90 acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
