CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That LILIAN G. OSWELL

of Garibaldi, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring a tributary of Tillamook Bay for the purpose of domestic supplies for one family under Permit No. 16278 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 20, 1945.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.010 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4, (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 20, Township 1 North, Range 10 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 4 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 20
Township 1 North, Range 10 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:

All that part of the following described tracts lying North of the Oregon Coast Highway; Commencing at a point on the Meander line of Tillamook Bay in Sec. 20, T. 1 N., R. 10 W., W. M., 9.14 chains West of the meander corner between Secs. 20 and 21, in said township thence North 15.99 chains to North line of D.D. Bayleys pre-emption claim; thence East 200.0 ft.; thence South to Tillamook Bay; thence Westerly to place of beginning, less R. R. right of way. and Beginning at a point 34 links South and 324 links West of meander corner between Secs. 20 and 21, T. 1 North, R. 10 West, W. M., being 50 ft. East of a small creek emptying into Tillamook Bay; thence North to North line of D. E. Bayley's pre-emption claim; thence West along said North line to stake at Northeast corner of I. I. Handley tract; thence South to Tillamook Bay; thence Easterly to beginning, containing 5 acres more or less, less R. R. right of way.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
