This Is to Certify, That WEYERHAEUSER TIMBER COMPANY

of P. O. Box 1645, Tacoma, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of McKenzie River, a tributary of Willamette River, to be appropriated under Application No. 26632, Permit No. 20864,

for the purposes of

storage area for floating logs

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1265 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 28, 1951.

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 123.2 acre-feet.
